

ORDINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING

Date: Monday March 23d. 2009

Place: Whiting Municipal Center

1. Roll Call: Coulthurst, Walkush, Hoppenrath present. Also present: Jerry Walters, John Wachowiak, and Dan Kontos.
2. Persons wishing to address committee: Walters, Wachowiak, Kontos all items if needed.
3. Discussion and possible action re. changes to leash ordinance Sec. 7-1-10 sub (b).
Recommend the following changes to sub(b)
 - (1) It shall be unlawful to own, keep, or harbor a dog or cat which runs at large within the limits of the village.
 - (2) Under the provision of this section, a dog or cat shall be considered as running at large when it is not on the premises of its owner, unless it on a leash and under control.
 - (3) No person shall allow or permit any animal owned by him to defecate upon the property not owned by such person or without such other property owner's consent or upon any public property, excluding there from any property used for street purposes, without immediately removing feces.
Motion by Walkush second by Hoppenrath to accept changes to Sec, 7-1-10 (b).
Motion passed unanimously.
4. Discussion and possible action re. changes to yard ordinance. Action tabled until next month.
5. Dan Kontos informed the committee that the recodification process has been on hold pending approval of the ordinance committee. Authorization to proceed was given to Kontos and sections will be forwarded to the ordinance committee chair for distribution to the appropriate committee chairs
6. Discussion and possible action re. addition of Knox box requirements to building code ordinance. Additions to read:

1. Upon request of the Building Inspector, the Fire Chief shall provide certification to the Building Inspector that any such key lock box has been properly installed to the satisfaction of the Fire Department and this ordinance.
7. 2. No building permit or other type of permit or authorization issued by the Village of Whiting or any department or body there under constituted shall be issued or permissible unless and until any inspectable property required to be equipped with a key lock box is in compliance with this section.
Motion by Walkush second by Hoppenrath to add this section to the building code ordinance. Motion carried unanimously.
